- 1) Commissioner Born called the meeting to order at 15:00 / Pledge of Allegiance led by Commissioner Born.
- 2) Public Comments –Tracy & Kenny (805)419-0313 Joseph and Donna (360)275-4090

Above customers Tracy and Kenny (22226 NE State Rt 3) had concerns about their water bill, usually was around \$90 then went to \$200. Called and spoke with Dale and he was super nice, they called leakfinders and shut off water at the house and leakfinders came out and found no leak. However, the meter kept running during this time. Dale then did interrogation and gave it to the customers, interrogation showed 3 days of massive flow and they were wondering if something was wrong with the meter. Dale told them to look for the flashing spigot that indicates flow (leak). Dale came out and checked and then pulled the report.

Customers (22222 NE State Rt 3) Joseph and Donna neighbors with similar issues.

Jim explained the billing and asked if dye tablets were given. Jim said he has never seen a meter read like that in the decades he has been working for water districts. Jim said he would give them dye tablets. Jim also said there is a possibility that someone was stealing water but is unlikely. Also that debris builds up in valves over time and hamper them fully closing.

Jim said we would re-evaluate on Thursday, can give up to \$300 dollars leak adjustment if it is a toilet. If not toilet could be a service line or piping under the house.

Tracy and Kenny have 4 toilets. Jim gave them all dye tablets and explained quantity of water with a leak using a leak ruler with different size holes.

3) Accounts Payable were read and a motion was made by Commissioner Born to Accept and Approve Accounts Payable Warrants #10757-10779. Commissioner Satran-Loudin 2nd the Motion. Commissioner Born called for the vote.

39 Acres

Geotech report is done on the slopes and identified no issues, the final permitting is in process and preparing to submit to DNR. After last meeting went back and checked on export question, had already asked Tom Burke in 2021, and also asked DNR and waiting on response. Jim read an article that Dale provided and reported that Kade Erickson called to see about it going out to bid. It needs to go out to bid, Born asked if we did put it out for bid, Satran-Loudin stated that she believes it is not to that point yet. Jim stated that anything over \$50,000.00 needs to go out for bid.

MTA Billing
